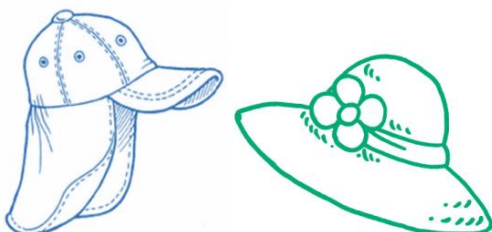


Class of the Week

Step 2: Participants complete the online registration form by entering personal contact details, uploading the proof of purchase and nominating the school to which the reward points should be allocated. To select a school, simply start typing the school name in the "Nominated School" field to display the possible options, and then choose the relevant school from the available list. All claims must be submitted by midnight **Friday 30th September 2016**.

Step 3: Upon submitting the claim, a confirmation email is issued to the participant to advise that the application has been received and claim details are being reviewed.

Step 4: Once verified, the participant is notified to advise that the claim is successful and the points have been awarded to the nominated school.
