School Expansion Update Access to classrooms for the autumn term

This week the school staff have been working very hard to ensure that all the classrooms will be ready for September.

To help parents and children, here are the access arrangements for each classroom:

Before school, parents and carers of children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are encouraged to walk with their child to the classroom door.

Reception classrooms (currently Year 3 and Year 4) – children to come around to the back of the building and enter directly into classrooms

Year 1 classrooms (currently Year 1 and Year 2) – children to come through the current Year 1 and 2 outside door

Year 2 classroom (currently the library and cloakroom) - children to come around to the back of the building and enter the classroom door directly into classroom

Before school, children in Years 3 – 6 are expected to say goodbye to parents and carers on the front playground and then walk to classrooms.

Year 3 and Year 4 classrooms (currently the temporary classrooms) – children to walk along the path, enter the temporary building and then into either the Year 3 or Year 4 classroom

Year 5 and Year 6 classrooms (to stay the same as this year) - children to come around the building and enter the classroom doors directly into classrooms
