PE lessons

PE lessons are an essential and enjoyable part of our curriculum. All children have two weekly lessons (a total of 1 ½ hours for younger children and 2 hours for older children). In addition, we offer a wide range of lunchtime and after school sports clubs.

The uniform for PE lessons comprises:
White t-shirt (with Team Colours if possible)
White or navy shorts
Black pumps
Trainers (from Year 3 onwards)
Kit bag

Please make sure all clothing is clearly labelled.

We would prefer that the only jewellery worn to school is a watch. If children are wearing earrings they should either be removed or covered with tape (if studs).

All children are expected to take part in all PE lessons, including Swimming, unless the class teacher is in receipt of a medical certificate or letter explaining the problem.

When getting changed for PE lessons, children are supervised at all times by the teacher. Younger children change in the classroom and older children split into single sex groups and change separately.
