#### **School Expansion Update**

#### Start date, completion date and Phase 1 work.

This week Balfour Beatty and the Local Authority were in school to finalise plans. The plan is for building work to begin on 3<sup>rd</sup> May '17. Our brand new Key Stage 2 building and refurbishments to our old building should be completed by March '18.

Before the building work can begin, some preliminary work will be carried out. If you have any queries or concerns about any of the above, please do contact me through either the school email or the school office.

#### Preliminary Works from 20th March '17:

**Prepare access for builders and machinery.** The Lollipops Gate will be permanently closed to parents and children. This will become the site entrance for builders. A temporary haul road will be constructed around the playing field. A material stockpile area will be created in a corner of the playing field. Secure fencing will surround the temporary road and stockpile.

**Create additional car parking spaces.** The existing school car park will be enlarged to cater for builders' vehicles and the increase in school staff.

**Temporary Storage for PTA.** An application for planning permission has been submitted for new garages for the PTA. In the meantime, temporary storage is being arranged. Mark and Sharon will share more details through the PTA.

#### **During the Easter break:**

The temporary classrooms will be moved. The temporary classrooms will be relocated closer to the school This will keep the classrooms away from potential noise from building work and will give the builders the space they need.

#### Phase 1 Building Works from 3<sup>rd</sup> May '17:

Removal of garages, caravan and canopy around the old Reception classroom. Building of the new Studio and small office to the front of the school. Additional temporary classroom. To accommodate our additional 30 children from next September we are having another temporary classroom.

#### Playgrounds, Playtimes, Lunchtimes and Access arrangements

Currently we are reviewing these. It is unlikely that we will make any changes to playtimes or lunchtimes. We will be making changes to playgrounds and access arrangements and as soon as they are finalised we will share them with you.


