Curriculum

This term some of our topics will be:

Head to Toe, Fairy Tales, Art and Artists, Minibeasts and Expeditions.

We will be thinking about healthy eating and looking after our bodies. In art and artists we look forward to the talent show. Will be reading a range a range of traditional stories. We will investigating minibeasts in different environments. We will think about things we need to go exploring and the different environments we might encounter on our way.

We will continue with phonics lessons, recapping sounds we learnt last term and also start learning new sounds. We will be working on instantly blending words and introducing more 'red' words.

In Maths we continue to become more confident finding one more and one less up to 20. We will be finding out about money, time and 3D shapes. We will be recapping addition and subtraction and using number lines and number squares to help us.

We will also start to use our new transition books ready for Year 1.

Reading Books & Homework Books

The children will still have the opportunity to change their reading book on a **Tuesday** and **Friday**. It is fantastic to see so many of the children reading regularly at home. Please remember to comment or sign so we know they have been read and are ready to be changed.

The time and effort put into the homework activities has been fantastic. It is great to see the lovely work done at home and helping to consolidate the work we do at school. Homework books are to be given in on **Wednesday** and will be handed out on Friday.

PE

Our PE days this term are **Thursday and Friday**. As the weather continues to improve, we may be outdoors for some of our PE lessons, so please could you ensure your child has pumps or trainers in school at all times and that all PE kit is clearly labelled.

Also could you ensure your child's clothing and belongings (such as sun hats and water bottles) are labelled; particularly jumpers and cardigans as the children start to take them off in the warmer weather.

Sun-cream

It is advisable for children to wear hats and sun-cream when (fingers crossed!) the weather improves. Sun hats are highly recommended, as some of our learning takes place outdoors. Please note that sun-glasses are not allowed to be worn. An all-day sun-block should be applied in the morning before coming to school as we are not-permitted to apply sun-cream for the children. Please remember to have your child's water bottle in school every day.
