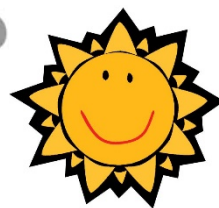


# Reception Newsletter

## Curriculum

This term our topics will be:

### Reading Books & Homework Books
