### History

Look at changes in their living memory and that of their relatives – how have toys and technology changed? What effect has this had on our lives?

### Geography

Looking at how the homes locally compare with homes in different parts of the world.

Identifying where different homes are located in our local area and conducting fieldwork to explore what they look like, what they are made of and the different features we can see.

Local area map work – knowing our address, writing postcards.

Observing and recording features of our environment – which materials have been used for different buildings?
