Pattern painting



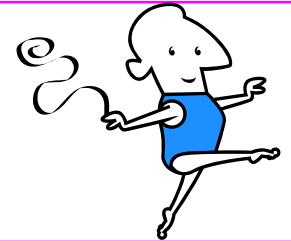
