Focus on shape in art- Paul Klee.

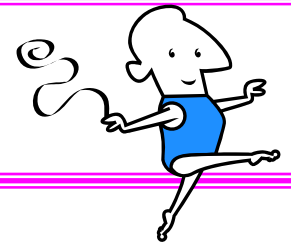
