School Expansion Update

This week we were pleased to host consultation meetings for the proposed building work. The architect, a builder from Balfour Beatty and two local authority project managers met with school staff and governors on Monday and parents and residents on Tuesday.

Thank you to everyone who was able to attend. It is important that the architect and project managers hear all our views and that we get the best possible building for children and staff.

If you were unable to attend one of the meetings, the building plans will shortly be available on the school website. Alternatively, we have copies of the plans in the entrance to the school.

Currently, we share the school site with Lollipops Day Care Centre. The local authority has made the decision to end their contract with Lollipops and so Lollipops will be leaving their current premises at the end of December. Many of our families use Lollipops for pre-school nursery care or Before and After School Club or both.

Unfortunately, as a school, we cannot provide pre-school care. However, I want to reassure parents that we have well-developed plans for our own Before and After School Club, beginning in January 2017. When allocating places, we will give priority to parents who currently use Lollipops Before and After School Club. Mrs Mills will shortly be contacting parents about our Before and After School Club.
