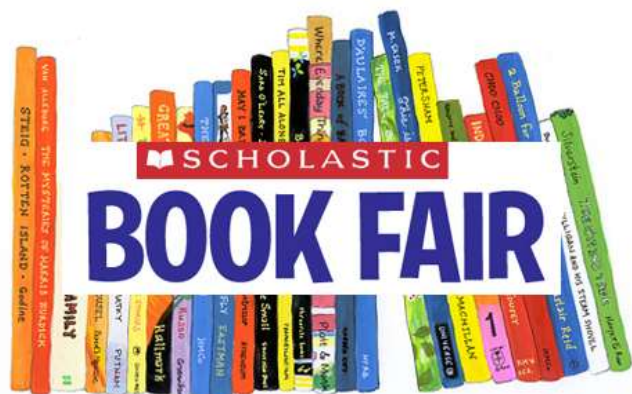
## Playground improvements
